G.S.R. – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Manager Grade - II in Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Ram Mahohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi, Manager Grade – II ( Group-B Post), Recruitment Rules, 2021.  
  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification, level in the pay matrix. – The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification. – No person, -
  - a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:  
  
Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation of the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(b) possessing the following educational qualifications:

(I) Bachelor's degree in Commerce / Business studies / Economics / Public Administration of a recognised University or Institute.

(II) 2 Years' experience in Accounts work in any government office or Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous or Statutory Organisation.

Note

The departmental Assistant Manager cum-Storekeeper with ten years of regular service in level - 4 of the pay matrix (Rs. 25500-81100) will also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case if the departmental candidate is selected for appointment to the post, it shall be treated as deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(The eligibility service for promotion to the post of Manager Grade II shall be eight years for persons holding the feeder posts of Assistant Manager - cum - Storekeeper on regular basis on the date of notification of these rules).

Note 2: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation /department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years.

Note 3 : The maximum age- limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
