In supersession of earlier Sanction Order of even number dated 05<sup>th</sup> September, 2014, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Rs.9,32,44,000 (Rupees Nine Crores Thirty Two Lakhs and Forty Four Thousand only) to the following States towards grants-in-aid for Strengthening of Immunization Programme during 2014-15.

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4. The States shall ensure that 25% / 10% of its share based on release of funds by GOI is credited to appropriate accounts.
5. The States shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/ SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
6. The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 206 to 215 of General Financial Rules, 2005.
7. The expenditure covered by this sanction will be met from the funds provided under Major Head – 3601- Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 02- Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head); 02.789 - Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (Minor Head); 34- FW – Reproductive & Child Health; 34.04- NRHM-RCH Flexible Pool - RCH Flexible Pool (New); .34.04.31- Grants-in-aid - General in Demand No.47 – Health & Family Welfare during 2014-15 (Plan).
8. The grants-in-aid now sanctioned is provisional and is subject to adjustment on the basis of audited figures of expenditure in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, letter No.2 (90)-P.II/66 dated 9.10.1966.
