- The above amount is in accordance with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance (Plan Finance Division) vide their O.M. No.10(1) PF-1/76 dated 22nd January, 1977 and is to be paid in Cash.
- The State shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MoHFW, Govt
- The State shall ensure that 10% or 25% of its share based on release of funds by GOI is credited to appropriate accounts.
- The State shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/ SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
- The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 203 to 215 of General Financial Rules, 2005.




