

Subject : Sanction of funds for the year 2014-15 under National Programme for
Prevention & Control of Fluorosis to the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Grant-in-aid of Rs.18,81,000/- (Rupees eighteen lakh eighty one thousand only) to Government of Uttar Pradesh for the implementation of the National Programme for Prevention & Control of Fluorosis(NPPCF) for the year 2014-15 in Raebarelli District.

2. The above amount is in accordance with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance(Plan Finance Division) vide their O.M. No.10(1)-PF-I/76 dated 22nd January, 1977 and is to be paid in Cash.
3. The State shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MoHFW, GOI.
4. The State shall ensure that 25% of its share based on release of funds by GOI i.e. Centre:State ratio being 75:25 is credited to appropriate accounts.
5. The State shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submitted Audit Reports, Utilization Certificate, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
6. The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 206 to 215 of General Financial Rules, 2005 as amended from time to time and Government of India decision thereunder.

8. The grants-in-aid now sanctioned is provisional and is subject to adjustment on the basis of audited figures of expenditure in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, letter No.2(90)-P.II/66 dated 9.10.1966.
