**Sub: Release of Grants-in-aid under National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme to the state of Government of Maharashtra for 2014-15 - reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the MOH&FW letter No. 4-10/2014-15/NVBDCP/Accts/GIA (Part File)(i) dated 31.12.2014 (Sanction enclosed) to the release of **Rs.1,25,77,000/-**(Rupees One crore Twenty Five lakh Seventy Seven thousand only) to the **State Government of Maharashtra** towards Grants-in-aid under NHM out of the Domestic Budgetary Support (General Area) component of National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme for implementation of VBD Control activities for the financial year 2014-15 through Treasury Route.


2. This grant is towards plan expenditure and should be utilized on the programme as per approved guidelines of National Health Mission Centrally Sponsored and no deviation from the provisions of guidelines is permissible.
3. The State Government should be release its share immediately on the receipt of this Central share for this programme as per guidelines of this scheme.
4. The State Government will furnish the certificate of actual utilization of this grant within twelve months of the closure of accounts. In respect of expenditure by the State Government through local bodies or private institutes the utilization certificate is required to be furnished by the State Government.

The expenditure involved will be met out of the approved Budget Estimates under Demand No. 47 – Dept. of Health-FW; 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 02263-Public Health Prevention and Control of Diseases (Minor Head); 08-Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases (New), 0802- NVBDCP-Cash Grants-GC (New); 080231-Grants-in-aid-General for the financial year 2014-15 (Plan).

6. No utilization is pending against Maharashtra Government.
7. Principal Accounts Office may issue an advice to Reserve Bank of India, Central Accounts Section, Nagpur from affording credit of **Rs.1,25,77,000/-**(Rupees One crore Twenty Five lakh Seventy Seven thousand only) to the State Government of Maharashtra with copies endorsed to Accountant General and Finance Department of State Government of Maharashtra.
8. The pattern of assistance or rules governing such grants-in-aid have received the approval of Ministry of Finance as required under Govt. of India Decision (1) below Rule 20 of Delegation of Financial Powers.
