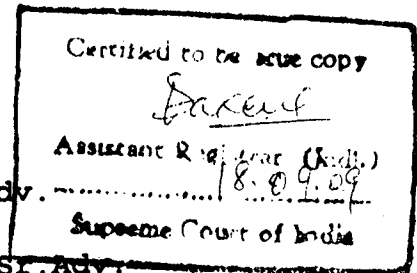

O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct that the Director General of Health Services-Respondent No.2 will call for information regarding the left over seats from defaulting States as also unallotted seats by 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2009, on which date he shall notify 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2009, to 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2009, as dates for holding extended second round of counselling at Delhi. After the seats are allotted, the students shall complete the formalities by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2009.

Four weeks' time is allowed to the Director General of Health Services to file an application making a prayer for introduction of single window scheme. Within the same time, application for impleadment of other States may be filed.

Place the petition after four weeks.
