I am directed to convey the sanction of the MOH&FW letter No. 4-10/2014-15/NVBDCP/Accts./GIA (i) dated 19.03.2015 (Sanction enclosed) to the release of Rs. 5,85,55,000/- (Rupees Five crore Eighty Five lakh Fifty Five thousand only) to the State Government of West Bengal towards first installment of Grants-in-aid under NHM out of the Domestic Budgetary Support (General Area) component of National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme for implementation of VBD Control activities for the financial year 2014-15 through Treasury Route.
