The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.47 Department of Health & Family Welfare 3601 Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head) 02226 Medical Education, Training and Research Allopathy (Minor Head) 0104 District Hospital - Upgradation of State Government Medical Colleges (PG Seats) 010435 Grants for creation of capital assets (Plan) for the financial year 2014-15.

3. The grant-in-aid is subject to the following terms and conditions:-
- (i) The funds may be kept in a separate account dedicated to this Scheme.
  - (ii) The grant-in-aid should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned.
  - (iii) The grant-in-aid is subject to the conditions and principles laid down in Rule 206 to 215 of the General Financial Rules, 2005 and instructions there under, modified from time to time as well as other specific conditions that may be circulated from time to time.
  - (iv) The accounts of the grantee institution/ organisation shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provisions of the CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by Chief Controller of Accounts of the Ministry, whenever the institution is called upon to do so.
  - (v) The medical college/institution is not authorized to divert the grants or entrust the execution of the scheme for which the grant is made to another institution or organization. In case of it not being in a position to execute or complete the assignment, it should forthwith refund to the Government the entire amount of the grant received by it.

- (vi) The grantee institution shall furnish progress report of the activity to this Ministry. The Principals of concerned medical college/institution shall ensure the submission of the progress report of the activity to the Ministry on quarterly basis.
- (vii) Release of funds under this scheme shall be made conditional upon State Governments committing to incur necessary recurring expenditure for maintaining the facilities created under this scheme.
- (viii) Institution receiving funds under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMMSY) will not be eligible for funding under the present scheme.
- (ix) The State Government Medical College(s) would furnish utilization certificate to the Central Government of the instalments and also ensure that the State Government has released its 25% share to the medical college under the scheme.
- (x) In case of non creation of stipulated number of PG seats where necessary, the State Government/Institute would return the funds misutilised/unutilized alongwith interest by the State Government Medical College.

4. In addition, all the conditions laid down in the sanctions for release of previous instalments of the Grants-in-aid would also be applicable and to be complied with.

5. This issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their Concurrence Dairy No. C-2720 dated 25.3.2015.

6. It is certified that no UC is pending against the medical colleges in respect of grant-in-aid for the above mentioned scheme.

7. It is certified that the expenditure including this bill have not exceeded 33% of total budget of the Ministry during the last of the year 2014-15 and 15% in March, 2015.
