- (iii) The accounts of the grantee institution/ organisation shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provisions of the CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by Chief Controller of Accounts of the Ministry, whenever the institution is called upon to do so.
- (iv) The grantee institution is not authorized to divert the grants or entrust the execution of the scheme for which the grant is made for another purpose. In case of it not being in a position to execute or complete the assignment, it should forthwith refund to the Central Government the entire amount of the grant received by it.
- (v) Institution receiving funds under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMMSY) will not be eligible for funding under the present scheme.
- (vi) The State / UT Government would furnish utilization certificate to the Central Government of the instalments and also ensure that it has released its share under the scheme.
- (vii) The State / UT Government must ensure proper implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by it with the Central Government under the Scheme.
