- G.S.R. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Directorate General of Health Services, Research Officer (Goitre) Recruitment Rules, 1977 and Research Officer (Nutrition) Recruitment Rules, 1984, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Research Officer (Nutrition & IDD) in the Directorate General of Health Services, namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement
 - (1) These rules may be called the Directorate General of Health Services, Research Officer (Nutrition & IDD) Recruitment Rules, 2016.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and pay band, grade pay or pay scale The number of post, its classification and the pay band, grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc. The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification No person,
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Savings Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The Maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the last date of receipt of applications

For the purpose of appointment on deputation / absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay commission except where there
