NOTE: All the above medical colleges/institutes are required to furnish the following documents/undertaking for getting the Letter of Permission (LoP) by the Central Govt.:

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings. Equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- (ii) No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Govt. is granted.
- (iii) The Private Medical College should provide Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalised/scheduled Bank/requisite undertaking in case of Govt. colleges as per MCl's norms against start/increase in seats in above said course. However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their plan budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- (iv) The Medical Colleges/institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG students similar to PG students of Govt. medical colleges in their State.

IMPORTANT:

Last date for issuing LoP for the above PG courses by Central Govt. is 28.2.2015 for the academic session 2015-16. The colleges are required to furnish above documents immediately and well before stipulated time so that LoP may be issued within time. The formal letter in this regard will follow.
