- c) Explore avenues for development of methods in 'Competency based training and Certification of health professionals' and support MoHFW in developing skill based training for service providers
- d) Examine laws relating to Public Health in India (Centre and State laws including Model Acts) and support MoHFW in development of Model Public Health Act and also support States in promulgating State specific Public Health Acts
- e) Examine laws relating to Clinical Establishments regulation in India and also support MoHFW in development of Clinical Establishments rules [Central and State (model) rules]
- f) Study implementation of laws relating to public health in India and evolve key strategies for improving their implementation and facilitate States in effecting implementation
- g) Undertake such other assignments, which may be assigned by the Advisor to the division or Executive Director

- I) Post graduation in Public Health (Desirable: Qualification in Law or Experience in Public Health Administration)
- II) A minimum of 5 years post qualification experience in public health with a special focus in;

- (a) Experience in developing legal frameworks or addressing legal issues w.r.t Health Sector / Public Health
- (b) Experience in implementation Public Health Programmes (experience of working with the State)
- (c) Ability to liaison with stakeholders / development partners for undertaking Public Health initiatives in the States
- (d) Willingness to travel extensively to states for stakeholder consultations, organizing and conducting workshops etc.
- (e) Any relevant publications in the area of Public Health & Law would be an added advantage
