 - Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant by the Government of India (c) shall not, without prior approval of the Government of India, be disposed of, encumbered or utilised for the purpose other than those for which the grant is being
- The accounts of the implementing agency shall be open to Internal Audit of the (d) Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare as well as the Statutory Audit by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India at his discretion and he shall have the right to demand the production of books, accounts, connected vouchers and other documents and papers in this regard.
- The concerned implementing agency will be under obligation to update progress (e) status to this Department periodically.
- The Implementing Agencies will follow other terms and conditions contained in the (f) General Financial Rules 2005, as amended from time to time.
- Any unspent balance of grant, which is not spent for the purpose for which it is (g) sanctioned during the financial year shall be refunded to the Government of India or adjusted for further utilization at the end of the financial year.
- It will be the obligation of the concerned State/UTs / implementing agency to put in place an internal mechanism for concurrent monitoring of the project and addressing any shortcomings / bottlenecks without delay.
