Subject: Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "National Mission on Medicinal Plants" - Release of grant-in-aid (SCSP Category) under State Plan through State Treasury to the State of Karnataka - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Office's letter of even no. dated 23.06.2014 about the administrative approval for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "National Mission on Medicinal Plants" by **National Horticulture Mission Agency, Karnataka** with an annual outlay of Rs. 147.76 lakh against the approved activities for the Annual Action Plan for the year 2014-15 as recommended during the meeting of 20<sup>th</sup> SFC held on 19.05.2014 and accordingly, to undertake the following activities during 2014-15:

2. It has now been decided to release Rs. 110.82 lakh @75% of approved amount of 147.76 lakh as assistance.
3. As per Census of India, 2011, the SC population in the State of Karnataka is 17.15%. Accordingly, Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to the payment of Rs. 19,00,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh only) under **SCSP category**, to Government of Karnataka during 2014-15, for implementation of the Scheme in Karnataka as per its Operational Guidelines and approved activities of Annual Action Plan.
5. The assistance under the scheme is 100% funding by Central Government under the existing scheme viz. Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "National Mission on Medicinal Plants".
6. This is non-recurring grant-in-aid for the year 2014-15.
7. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Reserve Bank of India may please be advised for debiting to the Account of Department of AYUSH (NMPB) and pass on the credit to the Central Account Section, for transfer to the State Government of Karnataka.
8. The said Grants-in-aid will be subject to the following conditions:-
  - (a) The grants shall be utilised and disbursed by the concerned implementing agency in accordance with the Operational Guidelines of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "National Mission on Medicinal Plants"/ Administrative Approval for the year 2014-15 and in accordance with the conditions stipulated in this letter.
  - (b) The implementing agency shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure incurred and submit the statement of audited accounts and Utilisation Certificate to this Department as soon as possible after the closure of the financial year.
  - (c) Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant by the Government of India shall not, without prior approval of the Government of India, be disposed of, encumbered or utilised for the purpose other than those for which the grant is being sanctioned.
  - (d) The accounts of the implementing agency shall be open to Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare as well as the Statutory Audit by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India at his discretion and he shall have the right to demand the production of books, accounts, connected vouchers and other documents and papers in this regard.
  - (e) The concerned implementing agency will be under obligation to update progress status to this Department periodically.
  - (f) The Implementing Agencies will follow other terms and conditions contained in the General Financial Rules 2005, as amended from time to time.

- (g) Any unspent balance of grant, which is not spent for the purpose for which it is sanctioned during the financial year shall be refunded to the Government of India or adjusted for further utilization at the end of the financial year.
- (h) It will be the obligation of the concerned State/UTs / implementing agency to put in place an internal mechanism for concurrent monitoring of the project and addressing any shortcomings / bottlenecks without delay. State and U.T. / implementing agency will also track the yield of medicinal plant raw material and its linkages with AYUSH industry.

9. The expenditure covered by this sanction will be met from the funds provided under Grant No. 48, Department of AYUSH, 2014-15 (Plan) Major Head-3601- Grant – in- Aid to State Governments (Major Head), 02 Grants for state Plan Schemes, and Minor Heads as detailed below:
