

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the MOH&FW letter No. 4-10/2014-15/NVBDCP/Accts/GIA/DBS (Part File)(i) dated 17.07.2014 (Sanction enclosed) to the release of **Rs. 1,20,94,000/-** (Rupees One crore Twenty lakh Ninety Four thousand only) to the **State Government of Punjab** towards first installment of Grants-in-aid under NHM out of the Domestic Budgetary Support (General Area) component of National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme for implementation of VBD Control activities for the financial year 2014-15 through Treasury Route.

2. This grant is towards plan expenditure and should be utilized on the programme as per approved guidelines of National Rural Health Mission Centrally Sponsored and no deviation from the provisions of guidelines is permissible.
3. The State Government should be release its share immediately on the receipt of this Central share for this programme as per guidelines of this scheme.
4. The State Government will furnish the certificate of actual utilization of this grant within twelve months of the closure of accounts. In respect of expenditure by the State Government through local bodies or private institutes the utilization certificate is required to be furnished by the State Government.
5. The expenditure involved will be met out of the approved Budget Estimates under Demand No. 47 – Dept. of Health-FW; 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 02263-Public Health Prevention and Control of Diseases (Minor Head); 08-Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases (New), 0802- NVBDCP-Cash Grants-GC (New); 080231-Grants-in-aid-General for the financial year 2014-15 (Plan).

6. No utilization is pending against Punjab Government.
7. Principal Accounts Office may issue an advice to Reserve Bank of India, Central Accounts Section, Nagpur from affording credit of **Rs. 1,20,94,000/-** (Rupees One crore Twenty lakh Ninety Four thousand only) to the State Government of Punjab with copies endorsed to Accountant General and Finance Department of State Government of Punjab.

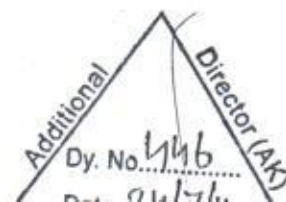
2. Authorisation to incur expenditure will be subject to the guidelines, terms and conditions laid down in the Administrative Approval of the State PIP for 2014-15, Records of Proceedings of the NPCC and other Program-wise Attachments and Annexures enclosed thereto. A certificate to this effect should accompany the Utilisation Certificates in the due course.

3. The State shall not make any change in allocations or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MOH&FW, GOI.

4. The State shall ensure completion of Delegation of Administrative and Financial Powers during the current financial year and funding of NHM Programmes will be based on clear delegation as per earlier directions.

5. The State shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Statutory Audit Reports, Utilisation Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
