

PARTNERSHIP WITH NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION

8.1 INTRODUCTION

The NGO Division in this Ministry was releasing grants-in-aid to Regional Resource Centers (RRCs) for providing technical support to Mother NGO/Field NGO to conduct capacity building programmes for implementation of the Reproductive Child Health Programme till last year.

With the issuance of revised NGO guidelines on 31.01.2014, Grants-in-aid to RRCs are to be routed through States concerned. Direct funding by the Government at central level have been discontinued with effect from the Financial Year (F.Y.) 2014-15 onwards. A Statement of Grant-in-Aid to RRCs during the Financial Year (F.Y.) 2013-14 is given in table below.
