Promotion: Stenographers Grade II in the level-4 (Rs. 25500-81100/-) with ten years regular service in the level.

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their senior shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.

Deputation: Officials holding the post of Stenographer under the Central Government (a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/ department, or

(ii) with ten years regular service in the level-4 (Rs. 25500-81100/-) or equivalent.

The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same3 or some other organization/ department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the last date of receipt of applications

Note 2:

For the purpose of appointment on deputation/ absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendation has been extended shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/ pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common Grade Pay/ Pay scale and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that Grade Pay/ Pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
