Please refer D.O. letter No.1(13)/EV/2017 dated 25th May, 2017 (copy enclosed) by Additional Secretary, Expenditure requesting expeditious revision of 7th CPC pension cases based upon DP&PW O.M. dated 12th May, 2017 which provides for notional fixation of pay of pensioners under 7th CPC Pay Matrix to arrive at the revised pension by Heads of Offices (HOOs).

2. It is observed that the progress made in revision of pension is not encouraging. As on 24th July, 2017 out of more than 9 lakhs central civil pension cases covered under 7th CPC, only 6762 cases have been received in CPAO from Ministries/Departments. Only Ministry of Civil Aviation has been able to revise about 26% (1986/7565) cases, whereas progress in other Ministries is poor. The main reason of slow progress is non-sending of revised cases to the PAOs by the HOOs.

3. The progress and pendencies of 7th CPC revision cases are provided by CPAO on the Dashboards of respective Joint Secretaries/Admin in charge and CCAs of Ministries/Departments on CPAO website.

4. I request you to draw clear timelines to complete the revision exercise and issue necessary instructions to Heads of Departments / Heads of Offices of your Ministry/Department to forward the revised cases to respective Pay and Accounts Offices (PAOs) expeditiously. The progress of 7th CPC pension revisions should also be reviewed regularly in weekly Senior Officers' Meetings (SOM).

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, orders have been issued by the D/o Pension and Pensioners' Welfare on 12.05.2017, based on the approval of the Cabinet, regarding revision of pension of pre-01.01.2016 pensioners. The orders provide for revision of pension in such cases based on notional pay-as-fixed under each intervening Pay Commission based on the formula for revision of pay.

2. I am sure that the process to implement the orders of Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare must have commenced in respect of cases under your Department. As the implementation on the above orders requires substantial administrative work, we have also issued guidelines to facilitate quick procedural action in the O.M. of even number, dated 23.05.2017. A copy of this order is available on the website of this Ministry.

3. The cases for revision of pension, in respect of which required data is available, could be processed forthwith. The cases of Officers, who retired in the Apex scale and in the scale above that, corresponding to the existing scale of Rs.2,25,000/- and Rs.2,50,000/-, which are fixed scales and were also fixed scales in the previous Pay Commissions, are fairly straightforward for the purpose.

4. Therefore, it is requested that cases of revision of pension based on the orders of Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare dated 12.05.2017 may be processed expeditiously.
