## Advisory to APHOs and Stakeholders staff for planning the logistics.

The responsibilities of APHO during the current threat of MERS CoV infection:

- The Offices at POE are to coordinate with the SSOs of IDSP units in case of any suspect case and for monitoring the arriving passengers for 14 days following return from Hajj.
- 2. Generate awareness to all the stakeholders at the POEs. For Immigration, airline staff and plan specific roles and responsibilities of each.
- 3. Arrange for safe transportation of symptomatic cases to designated facilities for clinical management of cases.
- 1. Contact tracing needs to be done in case a sick passenger is on board, by a passenger locator form.
- 2. Develop linkage with IDSP (SSO/DSO), hospital, labs, NFP and Dte. GHS
- 3. Plan logistics:-

PPEs requirements, lab investigations, hand sanitizers, dis-insectin of airports/rooms/ambulance and plan Health Screening Counter examination/isolation room at Haj Terminal during arrival.

4. Reporting mechanism.
