Sub: Central Pool MBBS and BDS seats – Allocation for 2015-16 session- reg.

The undersigned is directed to forward herewith a statement indicating the number of MBBS/BDS seats alongwith the Medical/Dental Colleges concerned, allocated for the academic session 2015-16 from the Central Pool for the Ministry of External Affairs (Students Cell).

2. The admission of candidates to various medical/dental colleges will depend on their fulfilling the eligibility criteria and other conditions of admission as laid down by the concerned State Govt. which may be ascertained from the concerned colleges.

3. The selection of candidates against Central Pool seats may be made as per the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997 of Medical Council of India, New Delhi. The copy of the merit list together with copies of allotment letters may be sent to this Ministry.

4. The selected candidates may be advised to report to the concerned college for admission by 30.9.2015 and an intimation regarding their actual admission alongwith their full particulars including their marks, be sent to this Department immediately. Ministry of External Affairs may consider moving the Supreme Court for seeking extension of time for admission.

5. It should be ensured that every selected candidate carries duly attested documents including his/her photographs when reporting for admission.

6. Intimation whether all the seats allocated to that Ministry have been fully utilized should be conveyed to this Department on most urgent basis. In the event of any default in this behalf, this Ministry may have no choice except to curtail the allocation, to the extent of the seat(s) lost or un-utilized, in the succeeding year.

Subject: Guidelines for Allocation of Central Pool MBBS/BDS seats for the academic year 2015-16 – reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that this Ministry has received a number of communications from beneficiary States/UTs/Govt. Departments seeking clarification on the mode of selection of candidates for nomination against Central Pool UG and PG medical seats.

2. The matter has been considered in this Ministry in light of judgement/directions passed by Apex Court in various cases and it has been decided with the approval of competent authority that as per directions dated 26.9.2014 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.9268-9269 of 2014 titled UOI Vs Bhawana Kumari Mallick & Ors, foreign national students of friendly foreign countries, nominated by Student Cell of Ministry of External Affairs for admission to Central Pool Quota MBBS/BDS seats have been exempted from the requirement of appearing and qualifying the entrance examination. However for becoming eligible for admission to Central Pool Quota MBBS/BDS seats, they must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause 4(2) of Regulation on Graduate Medical Education 1997 of Medical Council of India.


