The State Governments are requested to kindly note that the subsequent quarterly release of grants will be contingent upon the receipt of expenditure statements of the previous quarters and Utilization Certificates for the previous year from them and the unspent balance remaining at the end of previous financial year is adjusted/correspondingly reduced while sending the fresh proposals for release of the grants-in-aid, in future.


