G.S.R..... – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, in suppression of the Head Clerk, Accountant and Assistant Superintendent Store, Recruitment Rules, 1977 of Safdarjung Hospital, Assistant Administrative Officer and Assistant Accounts Officer, Recruitment Rules, 1996, Office Superintendent and Head Clerk, Recruitment Rule, 2005 and Assistant Superintendent Store, Recruitment Rules, 1996 of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Office Superintendent, Recruitment Rules, 1993, Head Clerk, Recruitment Rules, 1990, Assistant Accounts Officer, Recruitment Rules, 1994 and Accountant, Recruitment Rules, 1981 of Lohia Hospital, Lady Hardinge Medical College and Smt. Sucheta Kriplani Hospital and Office Superintendent, Recruitment Rules, 2019 of Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such suppression, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant in the Sajdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Lady Hardinge Medical College and Smt. Sucheta Kriplani Hospital and Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital, New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the Central Government Hospitals in New Delhi, Assistant (Group – 'B' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix. – The number of the said posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. – No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ;  
or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
