- Guide States/UTs in policy and program implementation in relation to programs.
- Gather and analyse evidence from field review visits from different states/districts to inform policy and advocate appropriate changes. Facilitate development and implementation of the scheme and proposals/strategies derived from the situational analysis.
- Provide technical inputs on thematic areas
- Undertake implementation and operational research and assessments for improving the programs and policies.
- Monitor the progress of the PM-ABHIM and provide inputs on a regular basis.
- Ensure consolidation and dissemination of approved annual work plans along with budget to implementing entities and prepare quarterly progress report based on results framework.

- Ensure consolidation and dissemination of approved annual work plans along with budget to States/UTs and prepare periodic progress report on the monitoring & evaluation framework.
