Kindly refer to the Minutes of second meeting of Digital Payment Committee organized under the Chairmanship of AS & DG, MoHFW held on 14th September, 2017 at Nirman Bhawan, MOH&FW, New Delhi.

In the meeting, it was decided that digital promotion program has been accorded highest priority by the Government and is being monitored by Prime Minister Office (PMO) at regular intervals. Further, the current status of payment modes in different divisions (whether digital or otherwise), actions taken so far on promotion of digital payment were also reviewed.

After the detailed discussion in the meeting following decisions were taken for NHM which the States/UTs need to adhere/comply on top priority basis:

- State Nodal Officers for PFMS need to be advised to coordinate, plan & monitor for Digital Payment Promotion in States/UTs.
- The digital payment transactions data of all the program/scheme (DBT including incentives to ASHA, JSY & and other payments) under NHM from 1st April 2017 to 14th September 2017 to be shared with the e-governance division of MoHFW on every 1st date of month.
- 3. States promoting digital payment would be incentivized in the form of recognition/award.
- 4. Rogi Kalyan Samiti (RKS) to promote use of digital payment.

You are therefore, requested to implement the above on priority basis, so that the assigned targets for Digital Payment Promotion programme are successfully achieved.
