Notification

G.S.R – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Bombay (Hindi Officer), Group 'B' Recruitment Rules, 1986, in so far as it relates to the post of Assistant Director (Official Language), in the All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Official Language) in the All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai.

1. Short title and commencement. – (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, All India Institute of Physical Medicine, Mumbai, Assistant Director (Official Language), Group 'A' Post, Recruitment, Rules 2024

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application-These rule shall apply to the posts in Column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules
3. Number of posts, classification, pay band, grade pay and pay scale. – The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc. – The method of recruitment age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. Disqualification. – No person, -
 - a. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living , or
 - b. Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes. Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
