Subject: Hospital Patient Care Allowance (HPCA)/ Patient Care Allowance (PCA) to Ministerial Staff (Group -A, B, C& D)-reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to resolution no. 11-1/2016-IC dated 6th July, 2017 (relevant extract enclosed) of Department of Expenditure (DoE) wherein the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission (7th CPC) were accepted by the Government, with modifications, that Ministerial Staff to continue to get HPCA/PCA as per R1 H3 (Rs. 4100 for level 8 and below and Rs. 5300 for level 9 and above) of Risk and Hardship Matrix.

- 2. This Ministry has issued OMs dated 04.02.2004 and 18.09.2019 (copies enclosed) regarding grant of HPCA/PCA to employees of various groups in Central Govt. Hospitals. No order has been issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to grant of HPCA /PCA to Ministerial employees.
- 3. In light of the guiding principle of grant of HPCA/PCA, recommendations of the 7th CPC and aforesaid resolution, the matter of grant of HPCA/PCA to Ministerial employees has been examined in this Ministry in consultation with the D/o Expenditure and it has been decided:
 - (i) To discontinue HPCA/PCA to Ministerial Staff of all Groups working in Central Govt. Health Care Facilities from the date of issue of this OM.
 - (ii) All Ministries/Departments shall ensure stoppage of payment of HPCA/PCA to Ministerial Staff working in their respective Central Govt. Healthcare Facilities/Autonomous Bodies (including Railway, Defence, AIIMS, etc.) from the date of issue of this OM.
 - (iii) No recovery shall be made from Ministerial Staff who have been paid HPCA/PCA on the basis of DoE's resolution dated 06.07.2017. All Ministries/Departments shall submit the amount spent on payment of HPCA/PCA to Ministerial Staff for regularizing the same.
- 4. The eligibility for grant of HPCA/PCA shall continue to be governed as per this Ministry's OMs dated 04.02.2004 and 18.09.2019.
- This issues with the concurrence of DoE vide ID Note No.A-27023/1/2018/E.II B/7th CPC/Pt. dated 06.04.2023.

RESOLUTION

New Delhi, the 6th July, 2017

No. 11-1/2016-IC.—The Seventh Central Pay Commission (the Commission) was set up by the Government of India vide Resolution No. 1/1/2013-E.III (A), dated the 28th February, 2014. The period for submission of report by the Commission was extended upto 31st December, 2015 vide Resolution No. 1/1/2013-E.III (A), dated the 8th September, 2015. The Commission, on 19th November, 2015, submitted its Report on the matters covered in its Terms of Reference as specified in the aforesaid Resolution dated the 28th February, 2014.

- 2. The Government, vide Para 7 of the Resolution No. 1-2/2016- IC, dated 25th July, 2016, decided to refer the allowances (except Dearness Allowance) to the Committee on Allowances (the Committee). It was also decided that till a final decision on allowances is taken based on the recommendations of the Committee, all allowances will continue to be paid at existing rates in existing pay structure, as if the pay had not been revised with effect from 1st day of January, 2016.
- 3. The said Committee submitted its Report on 27th April, 2017. The Government, after consideration, has decided to accept the recommendations of the Commission on allowances with 34 modifications as specified in **Appendix I.** The Statement showing the recommendations of the Commission on allowances and the Government's decision thereon is annexed at **Appendix II**.
- 4. Some of the allowances paid to the Indian Navy which are also paid to the Indian Coast Guard at present have not been mentioned in the Report of the Commission. The Government has decided that these allowances which are admissible to the Indian Navy shall also be paid to the Indian Coast Guard at par with the Indian Navy.
- 5. The rates in respect of 12 running allowances relating to the Ministry of Railways shall be notified by the Ministry of Railways with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance.
- 6. The revised rates of allowances shall be admissible with effect from the 1st July, 2017.

Ordered that a copy of this Resolution be communicated to the Ministries and/Departments of the Government of India, State Governments, Administrations of Union territories and all other concerned.

Payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance to Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees working in hospitals, dispensaries and organizations.

Sir,

I am directed to state that Ministry of Finance had suggested to this Ministry that a clear cut policy for payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance to Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees working in hospitals, dispensaries and organizations be evolved. Subsequently in consultation with Department of Personnel & Training and Ministry of Finance, it was decided that in the light of the Cabinet decision on the payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance, it may not be appropriate to lay down the policy for Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance as the major para-meters of the policy have already been decided. Instead, perhaps a consolidated letter be issued in consultation with Dte. General of Health Services to remove all ambiguity in this regard.

Accordingly, the following Guidelines for implementing Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance are consolidated in consultation with the Dte. General of Health Services: -

i) Eligibility for Hospital Patient Care Allowance:

The Hospital Patient Care Allowance is admissible to all Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees excluding nursing personnel @ Rs.700/- per month and Rs.695/-

per month respectively working in General Hospitals (those with 30 beds or more), and in Super Speciality Hospitals (those with 10 beds or more), subject to the condition that no Night Weightage Allowance and Risk Allowance, if sanctioned by the Central Government, will be admissible to these employees.

ii) Eligibility for Patient Care Allowance:

The Patient Care Allowance is admissible to the Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees excluding nursing personnel @ Rs.690/- per month working in the health care delivery institutions/establishments (other than hospitals) having less than 30 beds, subject to the condition that no Night Weightage Allowance and Risk Allowance, if sanctioned by the Central Government, will be admissible to these employees. (Copies of this Ministry's Orders No.Z.28015/26/98-MH (H), dated 28.9.1998 and Z.28015/41/98-H (i), dated 2.1.1999 are enclosed).

The condition which an organization must satisfy before its employees can be considered for grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance.

Only persons (Group C & D, Non-Ministerial employees) whose regular duties involve continuous and routine contact with patients infected with communicable diseases or those who have to routinely handle, as their primary duty, infected materials, instruments and equipments which can spread infection as their primary duty may be considered for grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance. It is further clarified that HPCA shall not be allowed to any of those categories of employees whose contact with patients or exposure to infected materials is of an occasional nature.

iv) The conditions which an organization must satisfy before its employees can be considered for grant of Patient Care Allowance.

The persons (Group C & D, Non-Ministerial) employees whose regular duties involve continuous routine contact with patients affected with communicable diseases or are handling infected materials, instruments and equipments which can spread infection as their primary duty working in health care delivery institutions other than Hospital (30 beds for General Hospital; 10 beds for Super Speciality Hospital) may be considered for

grant of Patient Care Allowance. PCA shall not be allowed to any Group 'C' & 'D' (Non-Ministerial) employees whose contact with patients or exposure to infected materials is of occasional nature.

v) The classification of Group C & D Civil posts.

The classification of Group C & D Civil posts for the payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance as notified by Department of Personnel & Training vide their Notification No.13012/1/98-Estt.(D), dated 20.4.1998 is as under:

Group 'C' Posts

"A Central Civil post carrying a pay or a scale of pay with a maximum of over Rs.4000/- but less than Rs.9000/-"

Group 'D' posts

"A Central Civil post carrying a pay or a scale of pay the maximum of which is Rs.4000/- or less."

Department of Personnel & Training vide their Office Memorandum No.35034/1/97-Estt.(D)(Vol.iv), dated 10.02.2000 further clarified that the classification of the post held by the officer should be with reference to the scale of pay of the post held by the Government servant on regular basis and not with reference to the higher pay scale granted to the Government servant under Assured Career Progression (ACP) Scheme. In view of the Department of Personnel & Training's clarification, the Group 'C' employees who have been granted the pay scale of Group 'B' post under the ACP scheme would continue to be entitled to the payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance.

The Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance is payable to Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees working in the hospitals/dispensaries etc. This Allowance is not admissible to Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees working in

the Headquarters Office dealing with such Healthcare Units/Dispensaries/Hospitals as long as they work there. The HPCA or PCA will be admissible to such employees only in the event of their transfer from Headquarters to the Healthcare Units/Dispensaries/Hospitals and subject to the condition specified in (iii) and (iv) above.

The Non-Ministerial posts will be decided as per the recruitment rules of the posts. Though the power to declare an employee as Non-Ministerial rests with the Head of Office, this should be done only with the prior approval of the concerned administrative Ministry in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Training.

vi) The dates of eligibility in each case.

The grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance can be considered from the dates as notified by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. The dates of eligibility for payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance would be notified in consultation with the Ministry of Finance in all cases of grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance/Patient Care Allowance to the Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees in the future (Copy of this Ministry's Order No.Z.28015/60/87-H, dated 5.3.1990 is enclosed).

These issues with the approval of Department of Personnel & Training vide their U.O. No.239/03-Estt (AL), dated 20.6.2003 and Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) vide their U.O. No.362/E.IV/03, dated 3.7.2003.
