Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your proposal seeking permission of the Central Government for establishment of new Medical College at Baripada in the name & style of **Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College & Hospital** for the academic year 2017-18 & MCI's letter dated 23.05.2017 and to say that the Supreme Court Mandated Oversight Committee on MCI vide its letter No. OC/PRMMC&H, Baripada/2017/252 conveyed its approval for establishment of a Medical College at Baripada with 100 MBBS seats for 2017-18 subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant shall submit to MHFW, within 15 days of issue of notification of approval by MHFW u/s 10A(4) of IMC Act, 1956, the following:
 - (a) An undertaking affirming fulfilment of all deficiencies and statements made in the compliance report submitted to MCI/ MHFW which are signed by Chief Secretary/Health Secretary of the State.
 - (b) MHFW may thereafter, at any time in 2017-18, direct inspection to verify the compliance submitted by the College, and
 - (c) In default of the conditions (a) and (b) above, and if the compliances are found incomplete in the inspection to be conducted at the instance of MHFW, the College will be debarred from fresh intake of students for 2 years commencing 2018-19.

2. Considering the above, permission of the Central Government is hereby accorded for establishment of new Medical College at Baripada in the name & style of **Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College & Hospital** for the academic year 2017-18 with an annual intake of 100 MBBS seats subject to the conditions indicating in para (i) above.


3. This permission is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India.

4. The State Government should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings. Equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.

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5. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the LoP is granted for all India quota.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the notice of MCI and Central Government.
8. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.


