NOTIFICATION

G.S.R In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the and in supersession of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institutes, ASKA (Laboratory Assistant) Post Recruitment Rules, 2001 except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Laboratory Assistant in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, ASKA namely :-

1.Short title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the Ministry fo Health and Family Welfare **Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Aska,Laboratory Assistant** Group-C, Non-Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2.Number of post, classification, level in pay matrix: The number of said post, its classification and level in pay matrix attached there to shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to this rules.

3.Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4.Disqualifications.-No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

11. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Sheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-serviceman or other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
