G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of College of Nursing, New Delhi (Class IV Posts) Recruitment Rules,1973 in so far as they relate to the post of **Laboratory attendant, Clinic Attendant, Sr. Library Attendant, Store Attendant, Daftry, Peon, Cooks, Cook-cum-Bearer, Bearer, Bearer, Masalchie, Safaiwala, Mali, Chowkidar, Aya, Peon-cum-Chowkidar, Mali-cum-Chowkidar, Cleaner and Cleaner-cum-Attendant**, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of **Multi Tasking Staff** Rajkumari Amrit Kaur College of Nursing, Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi namely.

1. Short title and commencement-
 - 1) These rules may be called the Rajkumari Amrit Kaur College of Nursing, Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi (**Multi Tasking Staff**) Recruitment Rules, 2018.
 - 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Application.-These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in column(1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number, classification and scale of pay- The number of posts, their Scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. Method of Recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.:- The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit qualifications and other matters

relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of Schedule attached.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruits may be relaxed in the case of scheduled caste, scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders of the Central Government issued from time to time.

- 5 Disqualifications- No person
- (i) Who has entered into or contracted marriage with any person having a spouse living,
 - or
 - (ii) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax:- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do if may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving:- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
