## Notification

**G.S.R.....**-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Directorate General of Health Services (Library Clerk), Recruitment Rules, 2012, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Library Clerk in the Directorate General of Health Services, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Directorate General of Health Services(Library Clerk) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2.** Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.- The number of the said post, its classification, the pay band, grade pay and pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed to the rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc**. - the method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification. - No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving**- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
