



**NOTIFICATION**

The following draft recruitment rules, which the Central Government proposes to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution, for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Non-Medical) in BCG Vaccine Laboratory, Guindy, Chennai, Directorate General Health Service, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, are hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft recruitment rules shall be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of such publication in the website of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

2. The objections and suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft recruitment rules within the period specified above shall be considered by the Central Government.

**Notification**

New Delhi, Dated the 2018

G.S.R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Non-Medical) in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, BCG Vaccine Laboratory, Guindy, namely: -

1. **Short title and commencement .- (1)** These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, BCG Vaccine Laboratory, Guindy, Chennai, Assistant Director (Non-Medical) (Group 'A' Post), Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into the force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, classification, level in the pay matrix.-** The number of post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.-** No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. **Power to relax .-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving .-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
