The expenditure covered by this sanction is debitable to Major Head "3601"(Plan).03- Grants for Central Plan Schemes(Sub-Major Head), -03263 (Minor Head)-Public Health- Prevention and Control of Diseases-03-National Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Programme-0301-Cash Grants-030131-Grants-in-aid under Demand No.46- Department of Health for the year 2011-2012(Plan).



The State Government is requested to kindly note that the subsequent quarterly release of grants will be contingent upon the receipt of expenditure statements of the previous quarter and Utilization Certificates for the previous year from them and the unspent balance remainin at the end of previous financial year is adjusted/ correspondingly reduced while sending th fresh proposal for release of the grants-in-aid, in future.
