Notification

New Delhi, the 2024

G.S.R..... --In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director (Accounts) in the Ministry of Health and Family welfare, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. -(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi, Deputy Director (Accounts), Group 'A' post, Recruitment Rules, 2024.

2. Application - These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in the column (1) of the Schedule annexe to these rules. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix. - The number of the said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. -The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification. - No person, -

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service

Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Officers under the Central Government or State Government or Union territories or Autonomous or Statutory organisation or Public Sector Undertakings or Universities or Recognised Research Institutions:

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) with five years service on a regular basis in level - 10 in the pay matrix (Rs. 56100-177500) in the parent cadre or department.

(b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

(i) Bachelor's degree with commerce or Economics or Finance as a subject from

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recognised University; and

(ii) Three years' experience in Accounts and Finance in a government department or organization.

(iii) The Officer should have adequate knowledge of PFMS.

Note 1: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 2: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall not exceed fifty-six years as on the last date of receipt of applications.
