NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the2018

G.S.R.....— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Rural Health Training Centre, Najafgarh, New Delhi (Staff Nurse) Recruitment Rules 1989, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Nursing Officer in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Rural Health Training Centre, Najafgarh, New Delhi.

1 Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Rural Health Training Centre, Najafgarh, New Delhi, Nursing Officer, Group 'B' Post Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2 Number of posts, classification, level in the pay matrix. — The number of the said post, their classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3 Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc. — The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4 Disqualification. — No person, —

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living,

or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5 Power to relax. — Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6 Saving. — Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(A) (I) B.Sc. (Hons) in Nursing from a recognized University or Institute.

Regular course in B.Sc Nursing from a recognized University or Institute.

or

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing from a recognized University or Institute.

(II) Registered as a nurse or nurse and mid-wife (RN or RN and RM) with State Nursing Council;

or

(B) (I) Diploma in General Nursing and Mid-wifery from a recognized Board or Council;

(II) Registered as a nurse or nurse and mid-wife from State Nursing Council.

(III) One year experience in minimum fifty bedded hospital after acquiring the educational qualification mentioned at B(I) above.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates otherwise qualified.

Note 2:

The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection the staff Staff Selection Commission or the competent authority, is of the opinion the sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for the.
