The following draft recruitment rules, which the Central Government proposes to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution, for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Rajbhasha) in the Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Directorate General Health Service, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, are hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft recruitment rules shall be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of such publication in the website of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

2. The objections and suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft recruitment rules within the period specified above shall be considered by the Central Government.

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Assistant Director(Rajbhasha) Recruitment Rules,1985 in so far as they relate to the post except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Official Language), in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the Central Research Institute, Kasauli, namely:

1. Short Title and Commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Assistant Director(Official Language) Group A Gazetted, Non-Ministerial Recruitment Rules, 2016.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification, pay band, grade pay and pay scale.- The number of said post, its classification pay band, grade pay and pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification.- No persons,-
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.
5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with UPSC relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the central Government from time to time in this regard.

Master's degree of a recognized University in Hindi with English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level;

OR

Master's degree of a recognized University in English with Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level;

OR

Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi medium and English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level;

OR

Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with English medium and Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as a medium of examination at the degree level;

OR

Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as a medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at the degree level

(ii) Three years' experience of using/applying terminology (terminological work) in Hindi and translation work from English to Hindi or vice-versa, preferably of technical or scientific literature under Central/State Governments/Autonomous Body/Statutory Organizations/PSUs/Universities or recognized research or educational institutions.
