STATUS OF APPLICATIONS FOR STARTING/INCREASE OF SEATS IN BROAD SPECIALITY COURSES (MD/MS/DIPLOMA) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2017-18

It is informed that the last date for recommendation of MCI to the Central Government on the proposals submitted by various colleges for starting/increase of seats in Broad Speciality courses for the academic session 2017-18 was 31st January 2017 and the last date for issue of LOP is 28.02.2017. The Ministry has received recommendation for issue of letter of permission (LOP) in respect of 224 courses. The Ministry has issued letter to some of the colleges asking them to furnish necessary Bank Guarantee(s) and undertaking.

The colleges yet to furnish Bank Guarantee and other documents in response to the Ministry's letters are advised to furnish the same to the Ministry immediately, so that necessary LoP can be issued without delay. Those colleges whose applications have been recommended by the MCI and yet to receive the letter from the Ministry for submission of Bank Guarantee and other documents are advised to be ready with the requisite Bank Guarantee etc for submission to the Ministry at short notice. Details of recommendations received from MCI are indicated in the Annexure.

The Colleges whose Schemes have been approved are required to furnish the following documents undertaking for getting the Letter of Permission (LoP) by the Central government.

- i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings. Equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.

- ii) No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Govt. is granted.
- iii) The Private Medical College should provide **Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's norms against starting/increase in seats in above said course.** However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their plan budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- iv) The Medical Colleges/Institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG student similar to PG students of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
- v) The Govt. Medical College(s) (except those colleges located in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana & J&K) should give an undertaking authorising Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India to include 50% of PG (Medical) seats in All India Quota PG seats for the year 2017-18.
